



## Updated Camping Information

Checking in- Are you ready to get this party started? Camping spots are non-transferable. The original purchaser must be present for check in. If you bought multiple spots, they will be assigned next to each other. If you have other friends coming and did not buy the camping spots together, you should contact us in advance. If you simply arrive together we will do our best to accommodate getting you close to each other but we can not guarantee that last minute requests will be accommodated.

Check in times are:

Friday 2 pm - 9 pm

Saturday 8 am - Noon

Checking out- You can check out on Sunday night after the festival closes, or stay until Monday morning. Be sure to clean up your area and be careful when leaving as there will still be many campers walking around. Please heed the direction of security and parking personnel.

Check out times are:

Sunday 11pm -12am

Monday 8am - Noon

Your campsite- Each campsite is 10 x 30. You will be parking your car (no RV's) and setting up your tent *within your assigned area*. Once parked, you may not move your car for the duration of the festival. If you would prefer to leave the site throughout the festival, just let us know at check in and we will have you park close by in a lot where you can enter and exit at any time.

You are responsible for leaving the site spotless at the end of the festival. You may have a maximum of 4 people staying in each site. All camping attendees must be 18 years of age or older and have valid ID or else be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Sorry, no exceptions. Each camping attendee must have their own festival pass for entrance. No animals are allowed in the campgrounds.

Companion parking- There is room for one car in your parking spot, and ideally you will arrive all together in that car. If a guest must arrive in a separate car be aware they will not be able to drive into the camping area. They should park in the adjacent paid lot.

Community Firepit- We will have a community firepit available for you to gather around for warmth and entertainment. Please, do not cook on the fire!

Fire- There are no open flames outside of the Community Firepit. You are permitted to bring a personal tabletop grill with one 1lb cylinder.

Water- We will have a water fill station in the campground area. Please bring your own water bottle and stay hydrated!

Food- There will be food vendors available in the festival area and we will have fresh food for sale Friday 2-9pm, Saturday and Sunday 8-11am and again 9pm- late. If you run out or forgot something, stop by the market which is open daily.

Electricity & Lighting- Charging stations will be available for FREE in the market. You may also want to pack a flashlight and/or lantern as the campsites will not be lit overnight.

Showers- Showers are located near the market. The cost is only \$5. Tickets can be purchased in the market and showers are open 24 hours a day.

Toilets- Toilets are open 24 hours a day.

Trash- Bags will be provided at check in and there will be trash receptacles available for you. Please clean up after yourself.

Market- Did you forget something? Don't fret, we have you covered. The market is open on Friday from 2 pm - 9 pm, Saturday from 8 am- 10 pm, and on Sunday from 10 am - 9 pm. It carries toiletries, camping needs, snacks, ice, and more!

Alcohol- You are welcome to bring alcohol into the campgrounds, but no glass is allowed. The following limits are per person:

1 case of beer (in cans)

1 liter of alcohol (in plastic)

Safety and security- Security staff will be on site 24 hours a day. Please read through the Code of Conduct below and follow the direction of festival staff at all times. You are encouraged to lock up your belongings if not at the tent. Additionally, all valuables should be stored in your cars.

Coming and Going- All camping guests have in and out privileges at the music festival, just a short 5-10 minute walk from one gate to the other. Feel free to return to your tent throughout the day as needed. However, you will not be able to move your car if parked in the campsite except during the designated load-in and load-out times above. If you need to leave the festival and campgrounds early due to an emergency, please check with campground staff for assistance. You will not be able to re-enter once your vehicle has left the area.

Curfew- Security will close the campground gates 30 minutes after the Late Night Bar closes. Once inside, feel free to hang out and enjoy the evening. Quiet hours are in effect from 2:15 am until 7 am. Please be respectful of your fellow campers.

Medical emergencies- If you have a medical emergency, please see campground staff for assistance.

### **Code of Conduct**

Prohibited items confiscated at entry or during the event will NOT be returned. Please don't bring prohibited items!

- Security will present 24/7.
- Only camping attendees with their own festival wristband are allowed to enter into the camping lots.
- Only registered campers are allowed in the camping areas 24/7.
- Venue/promoter are not responsible for any materials misplaced, lost or stolen. It is recommended that you do not bring valuable items. If you do bring valuable items, please lock them in your car. Do not leave valuable items in your tent.
- Campers consuming alcohol must be 21 or older, verified by government-issued ID, which may be randomly checked at any time.
- No kegs of beer.
- No aerosol containers (including sunscreen and personal beauty products).
- No animals will be allowed in any camping lots (with the exception of approved Service Animals).

- No fires, tiki torches, fireworks, sky lanterns, candles or any types of explosives or ammunition.
- No laser pointers
- Only 1 car per camping package is allowed.
- All campers must be packed and vacated from the campground by 12pm on Monday.
- Quiet time will be enforced from 2:15 am – 7 am each day. Please respect your fellow campers! No amplifiers, ever!
- Camping lots open Friday at 2 pm. Please DO NOT show up earlier, as staff will not be prepared to admit you into the campground.
- No wrapped or sponsored vehicles. Your vehicle will be turned away at the toll booth if it has ads, marketing, sponsors or company logos on it. This does not apply to the logos from rental car companies.
- No branded or logo'd pop-up canopies or tents are allowed.
- All camping attendees are subject to search upon entry.
- No glass containers of any kind, weapons, knives (including cooking and steak knives), drugs or drug paraphernalia will be allowed.
- No squirt guns/water toys
- No large chains
- No tanks of compressed air, helium, nitrous (haha), etc.
- No drones, remote control aircraft or toy cars.
- No hoverboards or motorized scooters.
- No bicycles or skateboards are allowed in the camping lots.
- No flags or structures may be erected within 100' of power lines.
- No all-terrain vehicles, golf carts or motorized two-wheel bikes.

The following actions will result in IMMEDIATE EJECTION:

- Relieving your bladder or bowels anywhere other than approved restrooms/porta-potties
- Fighting or engaging in any action that may harm, endanger, threaten or bring discomfort to anyone
- Public sexual behavior
- Possession/use of illegal drugs
- Damage, destruction, vandalism or theft of any property
